• PowSyBl Annual Review

Ms. Tilloy presented on behalf of the PowSyBI project. Questions from the TAC:

- TAC members commented on RTE predominately contributing to the project and asked how for the project to change this dynamic.
- Questions on reusing code in the RTE Plasma project Ms. Tilloy indicated that there was code being reused. CoMPAS is also using some of this code.
- Interest in Grid Capacity Map and potential project Green Energy Hub in alignment with PowSyBI. Further discussion on three-phase modeling. Also interest in SOGNO collaboration.

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• RIAPS Emertius proposal - Mr. Dulaney made a proposal to move the project to Emeritus status, as the project is still quite academic and not ready for driving a larger community. The project will continue to be developed in an academic setting and will look to come back to the TAC when the project is ready for growing the community more.
