Release cycle process



EVerest release cycle

- monthly source code releases
 - continuation of the current release cycle
 - tagged around the TSC (every 4th Thursday every month)
 - this includes everest-core and meta-everest
- every 3 months release with feature freeze window
 - feature freeze begins ~2 weeks before the TSC
 - focus on stability with additional testing window
 - o no new features merged into release candidate branch during that time
